The 25th Annual Whitney Classic finished as a great success. 43 riders safely participated in the 2006 Whitney Classic. Seventeen rode as individuals, and twenty-six more were spread over 8 teams. This year's field consisted of both Whitney Classic veterans and first timers alike. The riders experienced a high temperature of 101°F at the start in Badwater with rapidly falling temperatures at the Whitney Portal. The riders gave their all while peddling 135 grueling miles. The effort paid off with 11 individuals and 7 teams completing the ride by Sunday morning.

The main function of the Whitney Classic is to help support the ministries of Summit Adventure. At the time of the ride, the Top Individual Fundraiser was Steve Atkins with \$11,475. The Top Team Fundraisers were Team STORM, with \$9,120. To date, over \$55,000 has been raised to help the ministry of Summit Adventure. With post ride pledges coming in until November 1st, we hope to double that amount to reach our 2006 goal of \$100,000.
